President Ellis welcomed the landowners to the meeting and introduced the District Board members in attendance and District staff. He then turned the meeting over to Manager Bair. Manager Bair reviewed the levee improvement activities that are being done to improve our levees because of the increased assessments approved by landowners.

Manager Bair turned on a shortened version of the 1955 Sutter County Flood Documentary. After the film, Mr. Ron Schuller, a survivor of the flood talked about how Yuba City and surrounding area was not prepared for the break in the levee that caused such a disaster. Mr. Tom Tisdale, also a survivor of the Flood talked about his experience and the family he lost during the flood. Manager Bair reported that the District is participating in a Flood Preparedness Project that will produce flood preparedness maps and identify flood material stockpile needs to help us be better prepared should we have flooding in our area.
