14	Who is responsible for trimming / clearing trees for access to place rock?	The contractor must trim trees as needed for the project's execution and handle the resulting materials by either stockpiling or off-hauling them. Special care must be taken regarding permits, particularly concerning the allowable extent of trimming and removal. The contractor is permitted to off-haul materials but may only stockpile woody vegetation in the designated staging area.
15	What is the contractor expected to do with downed trees in the construction zone?	Downed trees in the waterway shall remain in the waterway. Trees laying on the slope to be armored shall be removed as the contractor's property.
16	Is the contractor responsible for removing vegetation on site and off-hauling?	The contractor must remove vegetation as needed for the project's execution and handle the resulting materials by either stockpiling or off-hauling them. Special care must be taken regarding permits, particularly concerning the allowable extent of grubbing and root removal. The contractor is permitted to off-haul materials but may only stockpile woody vegetation in the designated staging area.
